## **Application Instructions**

#### Manual Mixing

- 1. Add 100 g powder to 30 cc water in a clean, dry mixing bowl.
- 2. Soak for 30 seconds.
- 3. Vigorously spatulate for 30 seconds.

#### **Mechanical Mixing**

- 1. Add 100 g powder to 30 cc water in a clean, dry mixing bowl.
- 2. Soak until powder is wet.
- 3. Mix for 20 seconds, 200 to 300 turns of the blade.

## Storage

Gypsum materials are subject to deterioration when exposed to the atmosphere. Store this product at 59-86°F (15-30°C). Keep container tightly closed once seal is broken to protect contents from moisture and high humidity.
